Friends of the Morrow County Dog Shelter is excited to announce our second Piano for Paws – Dueling Pianos fundraising event. We're thrilled to welcome back the Cleveland Keys, a crowd-pleasing group known for their high-energy shows at community events throughout Ohio. They're also dedicated supporters of local animal shelters and often use their performances to help animals in need. Proceeds from this event will directly support the dogs at the Morrow County Dog Shelter by providing comfort, enrichment, medical care, and essential supplies while they wait for adoption. Last year's event helped fund new play areas and equipment for the dogs at the shelter!

Each year, the generosity of local businesses, bakers, crafters, photographers, printers, and neighbors fill our raffle tables, auction displays, and dessert stations, and contribute essential services that help the event run smoothly. Because of you, these contributions are a beloved part of the evening and are recognized throughout the event and on our social media, helping us raise funds for the dogs who need us most.

What We're Looking For

• Raffle Items

Gift baskets or themed bundles (assembled by individuals or businesses), gift certificates, services, experiences, locally made or handmade items, and other donated goods.

Examples include:

- Services (oil changes, haircuts, grooming, detailing, lessons, etc.)
- Business-branded or “promote your business” baskets (products, gift cards, or services)
- Local handmade or artisan items
- Certificates or experiences (dining, entertainment, classes, activities)

Popular raffle basket ideas include sports team baskets, Italian dinner or food-focused baskets, gardening baskets, spa baskets, date-night experiences, or lottery ticket bundles.

• Silent Auction Items

Higher-value goods, certificates, experiences, art, specialty baskets, etc.

- **Bake Sale Items**

Individually wrapped baked goods, cookies, brownies, breads, or other treats, including dog treats! Full sized cakes, fruit pies, full pans of desserts, etc. are also appreciated. Bakeries or home-based baking businesses are welcome to include their business information with donated items.

Food-safety note: We cannot accept perishable items that require refrigeration, such as cheesecakes, cream pies, pudding desserts, etc.

- **General Supplies and Services**

We welcome donations of professional services that directly support the event, including **printing services** (programs, signage, auction/raffle tags, bid sheets, etc.) and **event photography** before and during the event. Businesses or individuals interested in providing these services are encouraged to contact us for details. Donations toward décor, event supplies, and food and bar items are appreciated and are best made as monetary contributions, allowing us to purchase and coordinate them efficiently.
